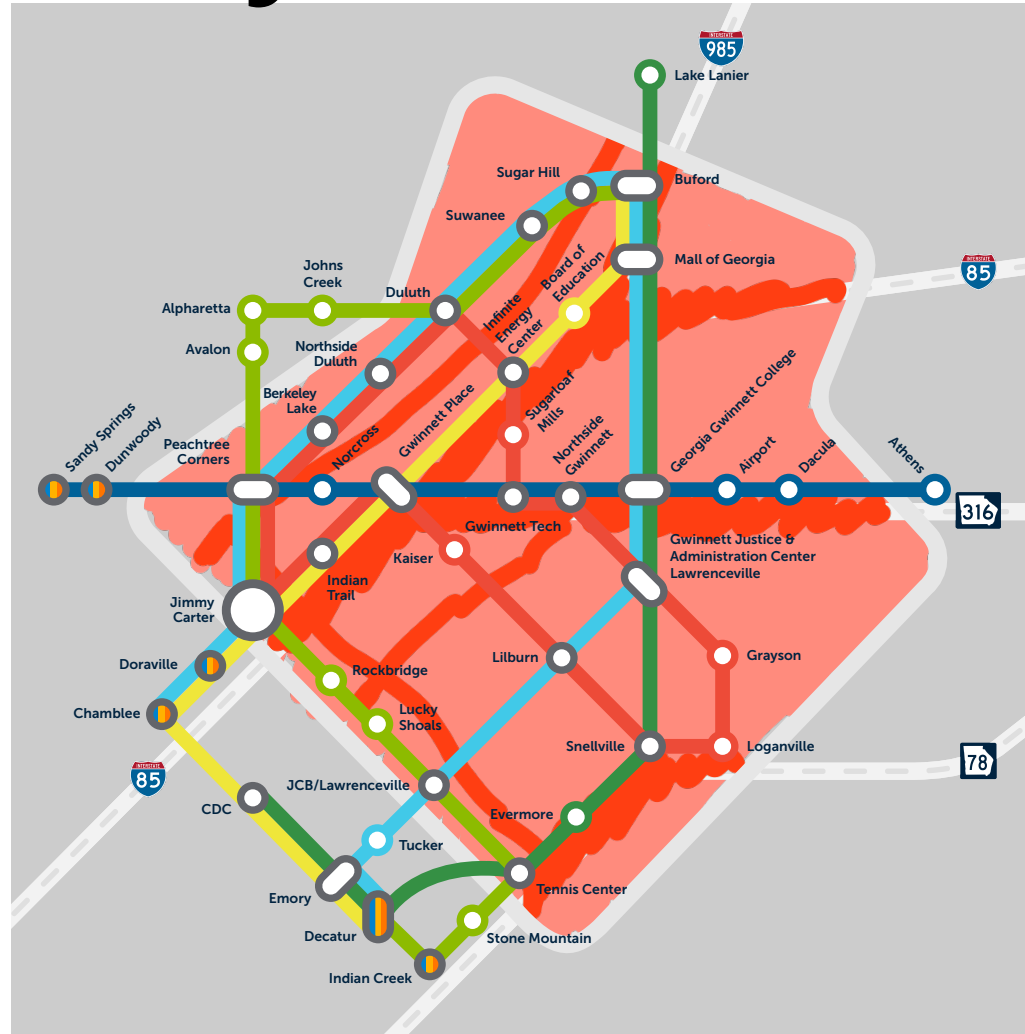
Strategic and development goals to create more livable and walkable communities with a sense of place.

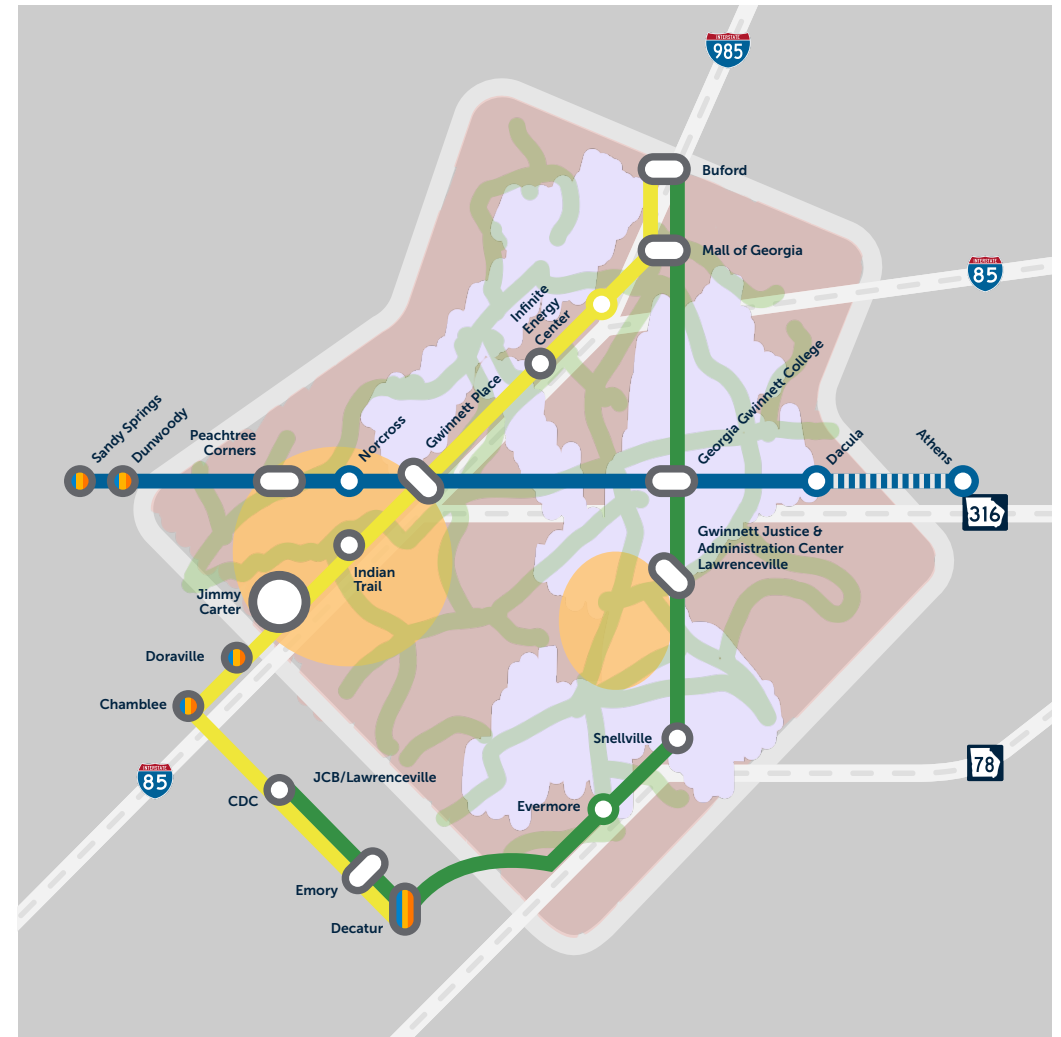

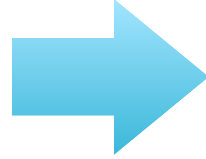

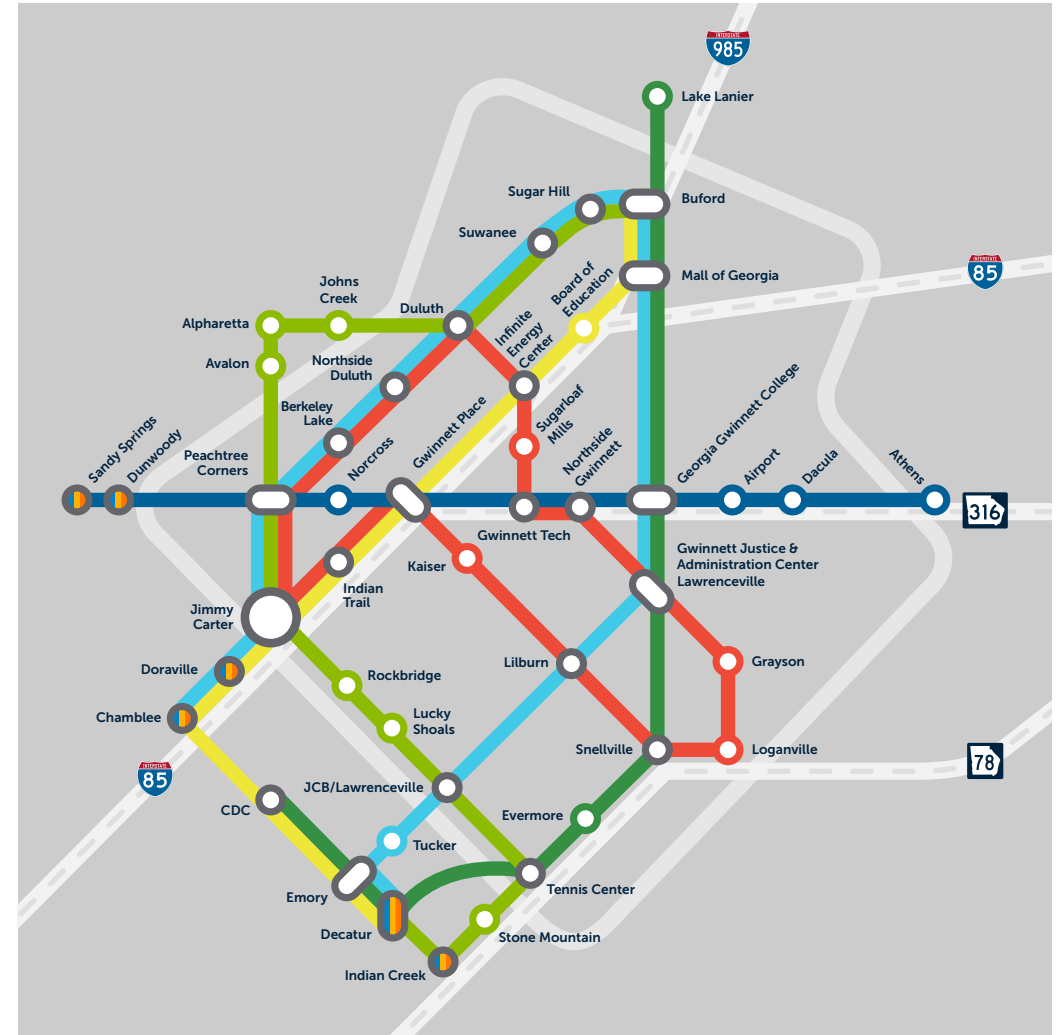
